

Christmas Markets on the Rhine, December 2021

Join hosts Wendy Rieves and Chris Kirsch as they sail with AmaWaterways on one of the newest river ships in Europe, the AmaMora. This vessel was built in 2019 and every cabin has a river view. There is accommodation for 156 guests in normal conditions which are currently reduced to comply with government edicts. There are multiple evening dining options, a sun deck with heated pool (how invigorating in December!), a walking track, fitness room, hair salon, and massage rooms. While we meander slowly towards the Netherlands, you will be captivated by the colorful Christmas markets in each town and the never-ending delights each stop has to offer!



Wednesday, December 1 Fly to **Basel or Zurich, Switzerland** on an overnight flight (or travel earlier if desired).

Thursday, December 2 **Basel, Switzerland** depart 10 pm
Arrive in Basel or Zurich and transfer to the AmaMora for boarding. This evening, enjoy the city or the onboard offerings.

Friday, December 3 **Breisach, Germany** In port from 4:30 am – 2 pm

From our Breisach stop, you may choose to visit *Freiburg* (30 minute coach ride), founded in 1120 and home to Freiburg's Münster, a Gothic cathedral constructed of red sandstone. You will also take in its enchanting Christmas market. Alternately, you may choose to visit the enchanting Alsatian town of *Riquewihr*, France (40 minute coach ride), beautifully dressed in her holiday finery with twinkling decorations and a lively market. On your walking tour, admire historical architecture, as well as famous sights, such as the Dolder Tower. We will enjoy an afternoon sail to arrive in Strasbourg around 9:30 pm.



Saturday, December 4 **Strasbourg, France** In port until 11 pm



Strasbourg is even more alluring during the season of Advent. The Christkindelsmärik dates back to 1570 making it the oldest Christmas market in France. Enjoy a panoramic bus tour that takes us past the Parc de l'Orangerie, the European Parliament, and the Place de la République. Afterwards, walk through the historic town center on the Grande Île, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and through the lovely "La Petite France" district, where we will see the Cathédrale de Notre Dame with its famous astronomical clock, and then visit the town's famous Christmas market. You may also choose to explore Strasbourg's different districts by bicycle. During the afternoon, visit Gengenbach Christmas market where every year the locals countdown to Christmas with a 24 day, larger-than-life Advent calendar.

Sunday, December 5 **Ludwigshafen & Rudesheim, Germany** In port from 8 am – 2 pm; 8pm-Monday noon

While docked in Ludwigshafen, we have the choice to explore two of Germany's historically rich cities, along with their festive Christmas markets. Visit *Heidelberg* (30 minute coach ride), a perfectly preserved medieval city nestled in the Neckar River Valley along German's Castle Road, a city that will capture your heart with its mighty castle and historic university. While here, wander along one of Europe's longest pedestrian shopping streets, the Hauptstrasse, soaking up the Yuletide celebrations. Alternatively, you can explore one of Germany's oldest cities, *Speyer* (30 minute coach ride), known for the largest Romanesque cathedral in Europe, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You'll also have time to visit its Christmas market in front of the "Old Mint" (Alten Münze) in the famous Maximilianstrasse, with a view of the romantic imperial cathedral (Kaiserdom). This afternoon we sail to the winemaking town of Rudesheim to arrive around 7:30 pm. You have the option of venturing out to taste local wine or one of the town's special delights, Rudesheimer Coffee.



Monday, December 6 **Rudesheim, Germany & Lahnstein, Germany** In port until 12:30 pm; 5-6:30 pm

Our exploration of *Rudesheim* continues with a choice of excursions. Visit Siegfried's Mechanical Musical Instrument Museum or enjoy a gondola ride to the Niederwalddenkmal Statue for panoramic views of the river, both ending at the Christmas market. Afterwards, indulge your taste buds with a sampling of Riesling wines in the vineyards. Alternatively,



you can join a guided bike ride or hike through the town and along the Rhine River. During the afternoon, we sail the scenic Rhine River Gorge with its fabled legends and many castles. Have your cameras ready! Upon arrival around 5pm in Lahnstein, we have the opportunity for a unique tour of Burg Lahneck. This castle resides high atop a rocky hill at the confluence of the River Lahn and River Rhine. It was built between 1240 and 1245 by the Archbishop of Mainz, Siegfried III of Eppstein to protect his territory and nearby silver mine. Then onward we sail towards Cologne.

Tuesday, December 7 Cologne, Germany

Join a guided tour through the enchanting Old Town of *Cologne*. Explore the UNESCO-designated cathedral and then visit one of Europe's largest and most renowned Christmas markets located in front of the cathedral. Alternatively, ride a bike along the Rhine and through the historic Stadtgarten, or visit a local tavern to taste Cologne's traditional Kölsch beer and Reibekuchen - potato pancakes served with apple sauce.

In port from 6 am – 7 pm



Wednesday, December 8 Amsterdam, Netherlands

Cruise the iconic canals of *Amsterdam*, considered the "Venice of the North" and admire the historic architecture along the way. Then, taste local specialties at one of Amsterdam's grand cafés. Alternate tours will depend on docking location.

In port at 1 pm

Thursday, December 9 Amsterdam, Netherlands

Check out of your cabin by 9 am this morning and disembark by 10 am. Bid farewell to Amsterdam as you prepare for your return flight home or continuation of your travels.

Notes: Pandemic parameters are currently in place which limits the cabins available. We have currently sold out our allotment but if occupancy increases, we are on the waitlist for a few cabins at our special pricing (a savings of \$520-\$1,800 depending on category). A deposit of \$1,500 is required to be added to the waitlist for new availability. Cancellation terms go into effect immediately upon reservation unless we are unable to obtain a cabin for you.



Timing and port excursions are subject to change due to river traffic or local conditions. Be assured, something fun will be arranged when changes are necessary!

Our goal is to include fiber related activities where possible. Once we confirm these opportunities, we will provide updates. There is a hands-on project available now with additional options during our travels. These activities are included at no charge and with optional participation.

The shore tours listed in the port descriptions are included and available to all passengers. You will have the opportunity during advance online check in to select the tours that interest you most. We will not pre-select tours for the group. You have the option once on board to make changes if space is available. AmaWaterways provides tours for Gentle Walkers, Regular Walkers, and Active Walkers. They often have a Late Starters group for non-morning people. You may also explore a port on your own.

If there is enough interest in extending in Amsterdam for a night or two, we will inquire of local fiber artists about providing a lecture and trunk show while there.

You may elect to arrive early in Basel or Zurich. If desired, we will assist in securing hotel rooms to extend the fun!

Documentation: You will need a passport, valid until at least June 15, 2022. Cruise documents will be provided once you complete online check-in with the cruise line. We will assist anyone having difficulty with the process.

Weather: You can expect daytime temperatures in the mid-30s to near 50 in a few ports with the nights dipping into the high 20s - low 30s. Snowfall averages under a half inch in December and doesn't stay on the ground long, we call this Hallmark snow! The ship will be warm and cozy and each cabin has individual climate control for your desired temperature. There is heated transportation for all transfers. Dressing in layers with thick, non-leather soled shoes will ensure your comfort.

Dining: River cruising features full service breakfast and lunch timeframes and a set time multi-course, dinner service. AmaWaterways has been at the forefront of service style changes due to the pandemic and has operated successfully within the restrictions this year. Your safety is paramount. Dietary needs will be accommodated.

Power: Europe and the ship use 220v/2 pin adapters. Most of today's electronics are rated up to 220 so only a plug adapter is needed. Other items may need a converter along with the adapter. Each cabin has a USB charger and one 110 outlet.

Air Transportation: Independent flights will be available for booking in January, 2021. We expect fares from Chicago to be \$850 minimum, higher if you select shorter duration flights at prime time. If you are not deviating, outbound flights will be

into Basel (BSL, 20 minutes from the ship) or Zurich (ZRH, 1 hour from ship) and return flights from Amsterdam (AMS, 45 minutes from ship). AmaWaterways will also provide flight quotes.

Insurance: Through experience, we have made it our policy not to include generic travel insurance. While including it makes it easy, finding that your needs are not covered by a universal policy makes that coverage a waste of money. We recommend independent agencies to find the coverage you need based on your work status, health, and choice of coverage level. Policy cost is based on total trip cost, age, and desired coverage inclusions. Cancel For Any Reason (CFAR) insurance is the only type that covers pandemic situations and has a significantly higher premium. Insurance is optional. We will be glad to assist you in obtaining a policy if you desire. Go to TravelInsuranceReview.net for an informative article on buying insurance. 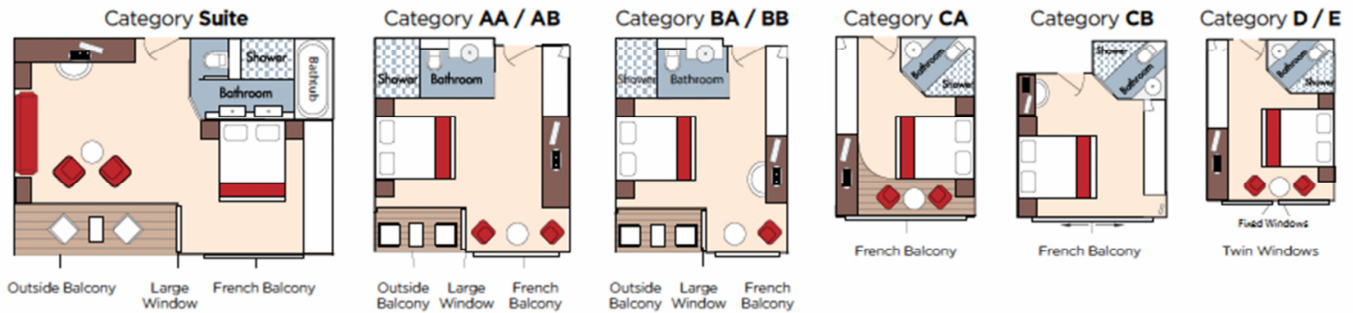

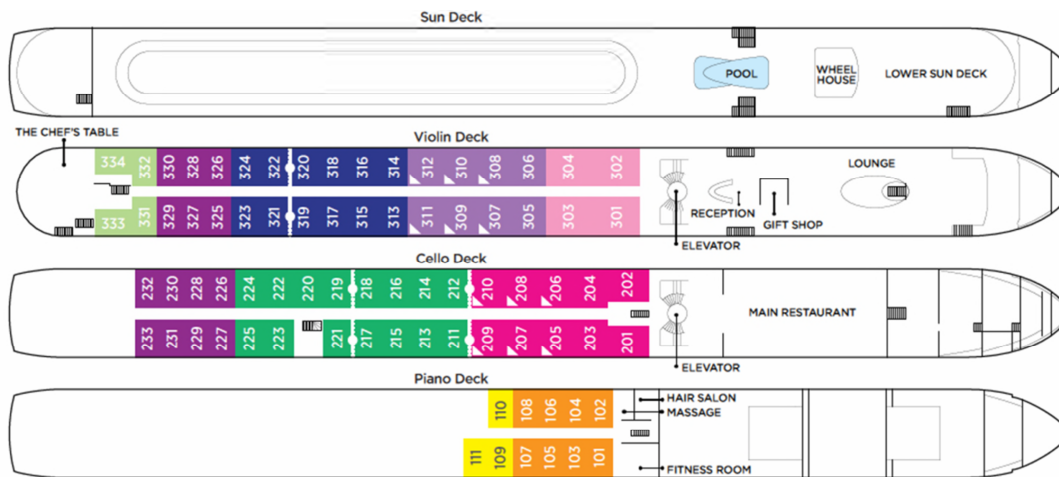

Terms and Conditions

GENERAL

- By registering and making payment, you agree that you have read and agree to the Terms and Conditions written herein. Your acceptance of these Terms & Conditions hereby releases Journeys & Gatherings, hotels, transportation providers, cruise lines, shops, and all other suppliers (further herein labeled Providers) from any and all claims involving health, disease outbreaks, safety, security, political instability, and labor or civil unrest at each destination. You also agree that the courts in Waukesha County, Wisconsin will be the exclusive jurisdiction for all claims and you hereby submit to the personal jurisdiction of those courts. (Exceptions with Providers enroute, suits to be filed in their jurisdiction.)
- There are times when unforeseen circumstances require a change in our trip offering or inclusions. Equivalent or better substitutions will be made where possible.
- When traveling with us, you assume complete responsibility for complying with document, vaccination, and other entry requirements of our destinations. Passports must comply with immigration regulations which may include, but are not limited to, having at least two blank passport pages when entering a country and having no less than six months from return date before passport expiration.
- We communicate primarily by email. An email address is required for each participant so we may provide updates, payment reminders, receipts, and confirmations. There is a surcharge of \$50 per person to cover the additional time, supplies, and postage required to accommodate non-electronic communication.
- Smoking is not allowed on any group transportation nor within 50' of the entrance of any vehicle or venue that is provided exclusively for our group.

SAFETY

- Be aware that during your participation, certain risks and dangers may arise beyond our control, including but not limited to: the hazards of traveling in undeveloped areas; travel by boat, train, automobile, aircraft, or other means of transportation; the forces of nature; political unrest; acts of lawlessness or terrorism; and accident or illness in remote regions without means of rapid evacuation or medical facilities. Providers will not have liability regarding provision of medical care or the adequacy of any care that may be rendered. It is understood that best efforts to ensure safety are taken.

PARTICIPATION

- Carefully consider your ability to participate. It is your responsibility to know your limitations and not undertake a trip or activity that might be too much for you. Our programs may include walking up inclines, traversing staircases, cobblestone streets, or uneven areas. If a medical condition exists or there is any question regarding your ability to participate in a safe and healthy manner in our programs, please consult your physician before registering for this trip. Failure to do so may result in the inability to participate and cancellation penalties will apply. Providers are not responsible for any expenses incurred in this situation.
- You must state upon registration any disability requiring special attention while traveling. We will make reasonable attempts to accommodate special needs of participants, but are not responsible if unable to do so, nor be responsible for any denial of services by other Providers. The Americans with Disabilities Act is applicable only within the United States and facilities for disabled individuals are limited outside its borders.
- Many transportation vehicles, including touring coaches, are not equipped with wheelchair or mobility device ramps. We regret that we cannot guarantee individual assistance to a participant for dis/embarking vehicles or other personal needs. A qualified and physically able companion must accompany travelers who need such assistance and must assume full responsibility for your wellbeing.

REGISTRATION

- All registrations must be accompanied by a signed registration form completed in full. We require the signature of each person traveling. In addition to the contact info requested on the form, names as they are on your passport, birthdate, address, and emergency contact info is required before we will accept payment to confirm your participation. You are wholly responsible for providing your full name as issued on your passport or government identification. Any costs for document corrections due to the submission of incorrect information will be the direct responsibility of the participant.
- Those wishing to participate in any portion of our itinerary must purchase the tour via Journeys & Gatherings. Partial participation is not an option.

TOUR ETIQUETTE

- Our itinerary has been designed for the enjoyment of all participants. Individual preference concessions may be required to maintain group inclusions and integrity. Participants are expected to follow the agenda as published and be attentive for any day to day changes announced, locations, current time as stated by Tour Director, and directives as to activities. Any deviations on your part require your full responsibility for costs and/or arrangements to rejoin the group without disruption to the whole.
- Repeated tardiness is disruptive and disrespectful and often results in added costs. Participants may be asked to leave the group for this behavior. Providers are not financially or otherwise responsible for anyone's costs to rejoin the tour, continue their travels, or make their way home should a scheduled departure be missed or if they are asked to leave the group.
- For the benefit of the entire group, we reserve the right to decline inclusion or remove any participant whose conduct is deemed incompatible with the interests of the other participants. Providers will not refund nor cover any expenses incurred if your participation is terminated.
- Pricing requires that schedule integrity be maintained. Comfort stops are included but additional comfort stops may not be an option (if motion sickness is an issue, consider ginger chews, prescription patches, or medications). Roads may be uneven with touring along winding roads.

AIR/FLIGHTS

- Do not book air flights until your participation in the trip has been confirmed to you. Providers are not responsible for flight or change costs purchased by participants at any time.
- Providers are not responsible if an airline cancels, reschedules, or delays a flight for any reason. If you miss your departure flight, it is your responsibility to work with the airline on which you are ticketed to reach your destination. Any additional expenses you may incur prior to joining the group trip are your responsibility.
- Journeys & Gatherings will gladly assist in the procurement of flights. We will schedule a phone or in person appointment and tickets will be booked through the applicable airline website.

TRAVEL/MEDICAL INSURANCE

- Travel insurance is an optional purchase. When traveling outside of the US, medical coverage is advised if health is a concern or your ability to pay in the event of an injury is limited. We highly recommend Emergency Medical and Medical Evacuation & Repatriation at a minimum. We recommend Squaremouth based on their 100% fulfillment of claims processed to date by our travelers. - Using the link above indicates you are on a Journeys & Gathers program which allows us to assist you should you file a claim.
- Policies purchased through a tour provider do not cover any other aspects of the trip nor protect you should they default. Independent coverage based on your age and amount you want covered is the only way to guarantee full coverage and reimbursement.
- Cancel For Any Reason (CFAR) coverage is currently the only type covering your decision to cancel when/if pandemic travel limitations do not prevent you from traveling.
- Journeys & Gatherings will gladly schedule a phone or in person appointment and walk you through the process while providing input on companies and coverage limits.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE:

- Portage for one suitcase is included in the price. Airport portage is not included unless otherwise specified in your travel documents. In general, airline allowances for checked bags are dimensions not exceeding 62" (L+W+D) and weight not exceeding 50lbs (22kg).
- Carry-on bags should not exceed the cumulative dimensions of 45" and 17 lbs. Carry-on bags must be small enough to store in overhead bins or under the seat in front of you.

- Should a roommate cancel and you wish to participate in the tour, you are responsible for the single supplement and/or cancellation penalties in effect on that date.

PRICE/PAYMENTS

- Deposits are as stated on the registration materials and are required to secure reservations and hold your place.
- We will maintain a waitlist of interested participants so we are prepared to fill spots vacated by those needing to cancel.
- Travel arrangements involving government regulated components are subject to supplemental price increases that may be imposed after you have completed your purchase (fuel surcharges, national, local, facility taxes, etc.). You hereby consent to any such price increases and will send a check or authorize your credit/debit card to be used for them when you are notified.
- Payments must be made directly to Journeys & Gatherings. Any payments made directly to tour suppliers will not be credited to your group program invoice resulting in non-issuance of documents and inability to participate in the tour.
- Acceptable payment methods may be changed or altered at any time. Currently, acceptable payment forms are check (on a US Bank in US funds), Paypal transfer, wire transfer, or credit/debit cards. Our pricing is based on cash/check payments to reduce costs. If you wish to pay by credit card or fee based Paypal transfer, we will process these transactions through Paypal with the surcharge.
- You agree not to file a charge back or refund request with your credit card company or Paypal but rather directly with Journeys & Gatherings. Filing requests through those providers will incur a fee of no less than \$100.
- Payments that have been declined must be replaced via expedited delivery in the form of a certified check or money order and must include a \$50 service fee. Failure to comply will result in your space being canceled and loss of your deposit.
